

Powell debate divides GOP

The Republican Party is split on whether to welcome the formal general as their candidate for the presidency.

might attract Republican voters who don't even agree with him on issues like abortion, affirmative action and welfare. Powell has expressed moderate views on those questions that appear out of step with the party's congressional momentum.

But some conservatives seem willing to overlook that in their quest for a strong candidate.

"I'm taking some heat from some friends on the right," said former Education Secretary William Bennett, who has not formally endorsed Powell but is a friend and said he would consider it.

Bennett astonished many conservatives when he suggested he could overlook Powell's support of abortion rights and focus on his other qualities — leadership, family values and patriotism.

"I think he could wallop Clinton," Bennett said in an interview.
