The Aggies had four singles layers advance to the quarterfials - top-seeded Blake Arrant, third-seeded Carlos Tori, Eric loran and Brent Horan.

Arrant and Eric Horan adanced to the semifinals. Horan efeated Arrant 6-3, 7-6 (7-5) to nove on to face Texas Tech's Mattis Rohlin in the final.

Horan lost in the final 6-2, 6but was happy with his play. lthough he is not making any xcuses, he attributes the deciive win to pure fatigue.

"I ran into tough competi-tion," Horan said. "(Rohlin) has experience from Sweden. I've been playing a lot in the last two weeks and had seven matches in


the last two days. Despite his loss in the finals, Kent is excited about Horan's play.




