Volleyball team sweeps weekend

A&M defeated Baylor and Drake at G. Rollie White Coliseum.

The 19th-ranked Texas A&M women's volleyball team rebounded from its five-set loss to the 11th-ranked University of Texas last Wednesday night with two wins this weekend.

The Lady Aggies defeated Baylor University (4-17, 0-6) Friday night and Drake University (15-4) Saturday afternoon.

In a non-conference game against Drake, the Lady Aggies came out strong by scoring six straight points. The Lady Bulldogs were able to come within five points of A&M after a long rally. However, the Lady Aggies came away with the 15-11, 15-9 and 15-6 win.

"I thought it was one of the best starts we've ever had," Corbelli said. "Although throughout the match we played impatiently and just wanted to get through it. We've been doing that a lot lately. I want them to enjoy volleyball."

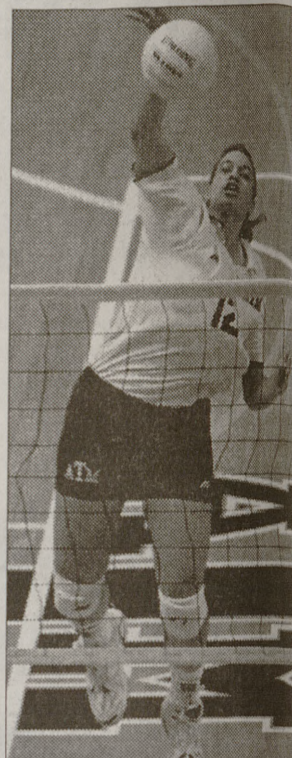
Kristie Smedsrud led the team with 13 kills and senior Dana Santleben set the pace with 17 digs. The only problem that the Lady Aggies faced was service errors — they committed 10.

"When we try tougher things, we take those chances," Santleben said. "It also a little bit to do with a lack of concentration."

In game three, freshman Stacy Sykora and sophomore Farah Mensik were brought in to use their jump serves.

"I decided to serve more aggressive," Corbelli said. "I don't care if we miss more just as long as it has intensity."

The Lady Bears came to College Station Friday in hopes of collecting their first Southwest Conference win this season. Instead, the Lady Aggies handed Baylor their sixth straight conference loss, 15-5, 15-1 and 15-11.

"I'm happy we could have a win like this," A&M Head Coach Laurie Corbelli said. "I tried to put more players on the floor and see how the starters would adjust. It was a letdown in the third game, but the starters regrouped and we still won. I was really pleased with our play."

Junior middle blocker Paige White, junior outside hitter Andrea Williams Smedsrud led the team with 10 kills apiece. Williams also had a team-high 10 digs. Cindy VanderWoude posted a team-high five blocks.

A&M outbit Baylor .343 in .010 and had 51 kills while Baylor only had 22. The Lady Bears top player, Nicole DeNault was held to nine kills, two digs and forced her to commit a team-high five errors.

The Lady Aggies will be traveling to Honolulu this week to play two games against Hawaii.

Lucky 13 leads to A&M tournament win

The Aggies defeated host George Mason and ninth-ranked Maryland this weekend.

The Texas A&M Soccer Team captured its second tournament title of the 1995 season, defeating George Mason 6-1 in the final match of the George Mason/Lanzetta Invitational Sunday.

The win ran the Aggies' winning streak to eight matches and improved the team's overall record to 12-3.

Up just 1-0 at intermission, the Aggies exploded for three goals in the opening five minutes of the second period to put the game away.

The first goal came courtesy of freshman forward Nicole Shook who began the rally at the 46:04 mark.

Bryn Blalack then nailed a shot in the 48th minute and Kristen Koop notched her second goal of the game in the 50th minute to give the Aggies a 4-1 lead.

On Saturday, the Aggies threw their third shutout in a row, upsetting ninth-ranked Maryland 1-0, only the second loss of the season for the Terrapins.

In a game made for statistics, Maryland lost to the 13th-ranked team in their 13th game of the year in the 13th hour of the day of Oct. 13.

"My favorite number is now 13," A&M Head Soccer Coach G. Guerrieri said. "The girls worked really hard. Their effort creates opportunities for us to win every game that we play."

Kristen Koop scored the game's only goal in the first minute of the second half. Sonia Ibanez intercepted a Maryland clearing pass 30 yards from the goal and passed it to junior forward Yvette Okler.

Okler hit Koop for a breakaway, 10-yard shot which deflected off the far post and into the goal.
