## Clippers defeat Mavericks

Los Angeles shot 64.5 percent to defeat Dallas 112-91 in exhibition play.

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) — Brian Williams scored 10 of his 21 points in the third quarter and the Los Angeles Clippers beat Dallas 112-91 Wednesday in an NBA exhibition game at Freedom Hall.

Holding a 10-point lead with 6:28 left in the third quarter, Los Angeles (2-1) outscored the



Mavericks 14-4 to lead 81-63 on a Williams dunk.

Williams had the final two points of the third quarter for the Clippers.

Loy Vaught added 17 points, including six in the third quarter, for the Clippers. Lamond Murray added 12 and Rodney Rogers had 11.

The Clippers led 100-74 with 6:13 remaining in the game, their largest lead of the contest. Dallas scored the next eight points, but the Mavericks (0-3) could get no closer than 100-82 with 4:50 to go.

Jimmy Jackson led Dallas with 12 points, while Jamal Mashburn had 11, Loren Meyer had 10, as did Scott Brooks and rookie Cherokee Parks, who also added six rebounds.

Williams was perfect in 10 field-goal attempts and had 10 rebounds and two steals while playing just 28 minutes.

As a team, the Clippers shot 64.5 percent on 49 of 76 from the field, and outrebounded the Mavericks 40-37.

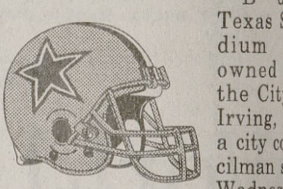
Dallas shot 46.4 percent, making 39 of 84, and had 18 turnovers.

## Jones avoids sharing

Owner Jerry Jones avoids sharing profits from sponsorships with the league.

IRVING (AP) — Rival NFL owners aren't the only ones wanting a piece of the Dallas Cowboys' latest action — lucrative contracts with Pepsi, Nike, American Express and Southwestern Bell Mobile Systems.

By structuring the sponsorship deals so that they're with Texas Stadium, rather than with the Cowboys themselves, owner Jerry Jones apparently won't have to share the revenue with the league.



Bu Texas Stadium is owned by the City of Irving, and a city councilman said Wednesday that most council members think the city is entitled to 8 percent of the multimillion-dollar, multiyear contracts because of provisions in the Cowboys' lease of the facility.

"We want to examine those portions of the contracts that allocate money for advertising revenues," City Councilman Harry Joe said. "That's the only way we can see for sure if it falls under the current lease agreement."

Mayor Morris Parrish said the city does not know how much of the contracts would be subject to the 8 percent share.

Bob Power, attorney for Cowboys owner Jerry Jones, said Jones has no comment about the terms of the agreement. Jones was out of town Wednesday and couldn't be reached, Power said.
