**A&M takes break from SWC play**

**The team is coming off a 3-1 loss to SWC rival Southern Methodist.**

The Texas A&M Women's Soccer team is not used to losing. On Wednesday, however, that's what the Aggies did, dropping a disappointing match at fourth-ranked Southern Methodist 3-1. That loss was costly for A&M as the Aggies were forced to surrender the Southwest Conference championship and the No. 1 seed in the upcoming SWC Tournament to the Mustangs.

But, the A&M loss could also prove to be costly for two other teams this weekend as A&M looks to avenge its loss and get back on track. The Aggies travel to Gainesville, Fla. tonight to take on the University of Florida and then will head to Orlando on Sunday to battle Central Florida.

Checking in with a 14-4 record and a No. 10 national ranking, their highest showing in program history, the Aggies will wrap up the regular season on Sunday. Left with a bitter taste in their mouths following Wednesday's match, the team is looking to rebound and salvage its road trip.

Although Florida is only in its first season of play at the Division I level, the Gators have been a headache to the majority of their

opponents. Florida entered the match with a 13-3-1 record. No. 21 ranking by SoccerWeek. "Florida will be one of the most talented teams we will see this year," A&M Head Coach Gerry said. "Their strength is their defense and their youthfulness."

A&M will also have to face the Gators' homefield advantage. Florida leads the nation in home record, averaging 1.82 goals per game.

"We look forward to the challenge to play in front of a large crowd to better prepare ourselves for our conference tournament and hopefully games in the Tournament this November," Guerrieri said.

Central Florida (8-5-4) has won three of its last four matches, will take on Dayton tonight, hosting the Aggies on Sunday. Golden Knights are the defending Trans America Athletic Conference champions and finished last season ranked No. 7 in the South.

"Central Florida has one of the most storied histories in women's soccer," Guerrieri said. "They are very athletic, and we always expect a very physical game."

A&M will be led by forward Bryn Blalack and Kristina Duda. The duo is currently ranked fourth and fifth, respectively, in goals and points scored in the Division I level. The two players are also the top four multiple-goal scorers in the season, a school record.
