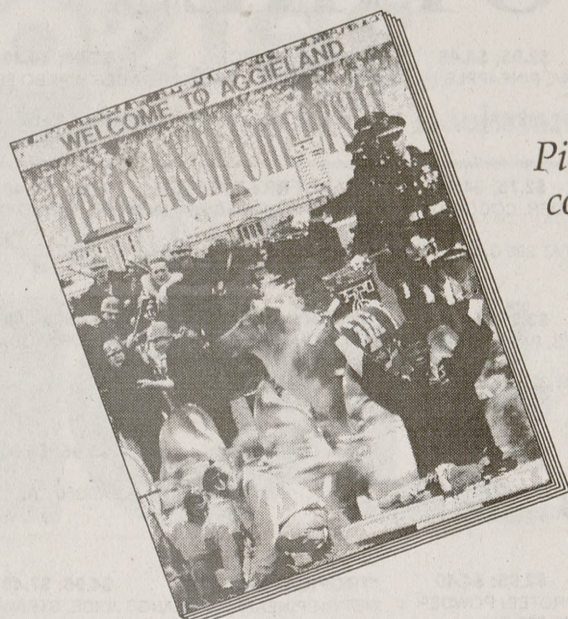

STUDENTS: If you ordered a 1995-96 Campus Directory, stop by the English Annex (across from Heaton Hall) between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. this week to pick up your copy. (Please bring Student ID.)

If you did not order a Campus Directory as a fee option when you registered for Fall '95 classes, you may purchase a copy for \$3 plus tax at the English Annex (by check) or in room 230 Reed McDonald Building (by cash or credit card).

DEPARTMENTS: If you ordered Campus Directories and requested delivery, deliveries will be made within the next few days.

If you did not order Campus Directories, you may charge and pick them up at the English Annex until Nov. 3. Cost is \$3 per copy. (Please have part number, FAMIS account number, account name, billing address, contact person and phone number that directories should be billed to.) If you have not submitted your work order for delivery, please fax it to 845-5408.
