and learn leadership and team skills.

APO accepts a new pledge class every semester with a new pledge president and officers. The fraternity has about 130 pledges this semester. Pledges are required to do 45 service hours and to attend meetings and fellowship activities during the semester.

Johnson said the high involvement required helps the pledges feel comfortable about joining a service fraternity.

"It shows them what APO is about," she said. "It helps them get involved. They learn about how it works."

"It just does a lot more for the community and A&M to have so many people in APO," she said.

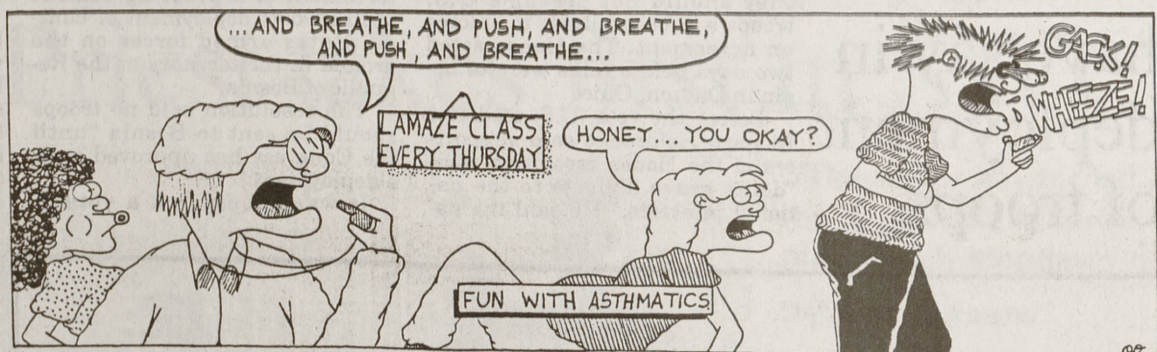
Walters said taking pledges twice a year also brings in more potential friends.

"A whole new group of people come in, so there's a lot more people to meet," Walters said. "Everyone gets excited about showing APO to the pledges."

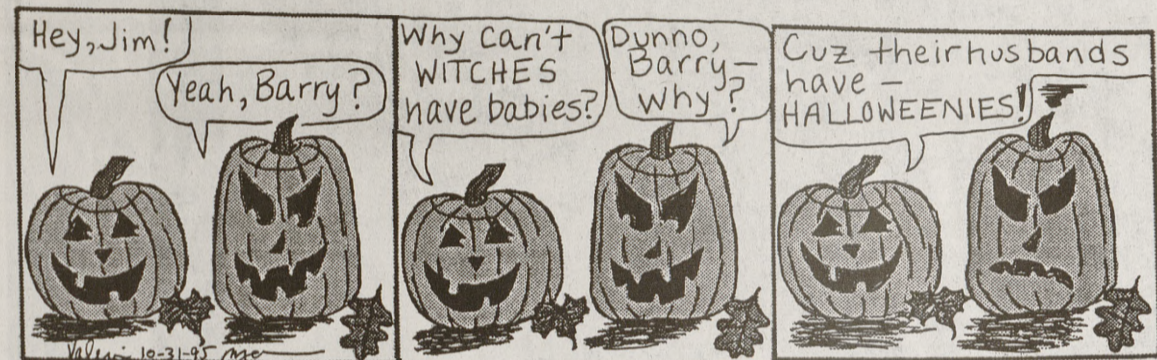
Walters said the fraternity does a lot of its projects off campus but it still benefits the University.
