A&M tunes up for run in non-SWC game

Following exhausting road trips to Hawaii and Utah, the Lady Aggie Volleyball Team returned home Sunday tired but satisfied.

After suffering a two-match sweep to the University of Hawaii 10 days ago, the road-weary Aggies put together two, five-game comeback victories over No. 23 Brigham Young University and unranked Utah last weekend.

Senior setter Suzy Wente said the team's rigorous travel schedule had a major influence on the team's play.

"Going to Hawaii tired us out a little bit, so we felt we didn't play up to our full potential this weekend," senior setter Suzy Wente said. "In the majority of the games we played, we were down 11-5 or 11-2 but, we came back and won

A&M Head Coach Laurie Corbelli said the team's five-game victories were valuable confidence builders.

"I was extremely proud of their comebacks," Corbelli said. "To be down like that and to fight back was something we haven't been able to accomplish in the past. It was definitely a highlight of our

season, in that respect.' Unfortunately, there is no rest for the weary as A&M returns to the spotlight tonight. The 17-

ranked Lady Aggies (17-4) wil take on the the University Texas-Arlington in their last home match of the regular season at a Rollie White Coliseum at 7 p.m.

"(Fatigue) may be a factor," Corbelli said. "We've been on bath to-back road trips and our play has suffered a little bit because of that

"Hopefully we'll get the opportunity to test out some thing we're really focusing on in practice with our blocking and individual

UTA (12-14), enters the contes on a bit of a roll, having won fou of their last five matches. Th Mavericks are led by Heather Ho and Dawn Foley. Hoy leads UT with 325 kills and a .236 hitting percentage, while Foley has contributed 887 assists.

"They're a young team building a program, but they have exper-enced coaches," Corbelli said "They have size in the middle and some versatility at the outside hitting position."

Wente, who surpassed the 5,000 career assists plateat against BYU, said the Lady Aggie should be well prepared to deal with the Mavericks' blocking

"They have a big block," Wente said. "But we faced BYU this weekend, and they have the No. block in the nation, so I think we're ready."
