San Antonio played without former Piston Sean Elliott, who averages 23 points but was sidelined with a sprained foot, and

saw their five-game winning streak come to an end. Detroit won its fifth in a row at home.

Allan Houston led the Pistons with 28 points, while Otis Thorpe had 25 and Hill had 19 points, eight rebounds and eight assists.

David Robinson had 37 for the Spurs, and Vinny Del Negro added 18.

The Pistons got within one, 80-79, with 8:54 to go, but Doc Rivers hit a 3-pointer, Robinson blocked Mark West's shot and Cory Alexander hit a running jumper to make it a six-

But Detroit scored the next six to tie it, and after Thorpe's finger

Robinson then hit free throws to tie it back up. It was still tied with 1:50 to go, but Hill put Detroit ahead with a dunk, and Per-
