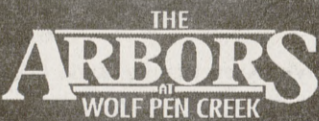

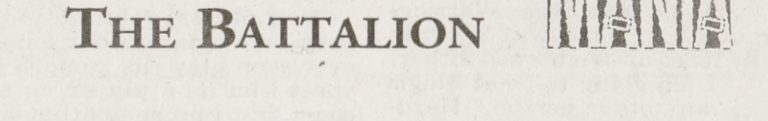

# Mavericks bad, Clippers worse

Jason Kidd's fifth triple-double of the season gave Dallas the win over the hapless Los Angeles team.

DALLAS (AP) — Jason Kidd had 21 points, 16 assists and 16 rebounds for his league-leading fifth triple-double and Jim Jackson scored 27 points as the Dallas Mavericks sent the Los Angeles Clippers to their sixth defeat in seven games, 105-101 Tuesday night.

Kidd's rebound total set a team record for a guard and he moved past Detroit's Grant Hill and into sole possession of the NBA's triple-double leadership. Kidd and Hill were co-Rookies of the Year last season. The triple-double was Kidd's fourth in his last nine games and ninth of his career.

Until Tuesday's victory, the Mavericks had dropped three of their previous four games.

Loy Vaught scored 21 points and Stanley Roberts added 17 for the Clippers.

The Clippers reduced an 11-point third-quarter deficit

to 88-85 on two Roberts free throws with 7:04 to play. The Jackson nailed a 3-pointer with 6:18 left, converted layup with 4:10 left, then George McCloud made a 3-pointer with 3:40 left to push the Mavericks lead to 96-85.

Los Angeles made one last run, reducing the Dallas lead to 99-94 with 1:05 remaining on Pooh Richardson's layup. But Jackson converted two free throws with 53 seconds left and Kidd made one of two foul shots with 37 seconds to play to give the Mavericks a 102-94 advantage and close out the Clippers.

Kidd already had his triple-double in the third quarter while the Mavericks were building an 80-69 edge.

Dallas led 84-77 after three quarters behind Kidd, who had eight points, seven rebounds and six assists in the period.

The Mavericks trailed by as many as 15 points in the first quarter and the Clippers rolled to a 30-20 lead after one period. But Tony Dumas came off the bench to score 16 second-quarter points and pace the Mavericks to a 54-52 halftime advantage.

# Oilers say they need 42 more luxury boxes

Nashville mayor Phil Bredesen said the city's obligation is to build 120 luxury boxes.

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (AP) — The Houston Oilers want another 42 luxury suites included in a proposed stadium deal to keep up with demand, Mayor Phil Bredesen said Tuesday.

"Our obligation is to do 120," Bredesen said as he briefed city councilmen on negotiations to bring the Oilers here. "That may be something that gets negotiated along with the other things."

Between 105 and 110 suites have been sold, according to officials for TENN-FL, the group handling the sales of luxury suites and permanent seat licenses (PSLs).

The relocation deal set a

minimum of 82 suites that had to be leased.

Suites cost between \$50,000 and \$125,000 depending on location.

The Oilers have refused to disclose the names of suite holders.

Bredesen said only two NFL stadiums, Philadelphia and Cincinnati, release that information.

The NFL team has the rights to lease the suites and will receive all revenue.

Negotiators for Nashville and Tennessee are finalizing three documents to replace a relocation deal signed by owner Bud Adams in November.

The Metro Council must approve a lease agreement for the stadium, a con-

tract for the Oilers and an agreement for the stadium.

The Oilers began in Houston in 1960 and would be the second franchise, after the Cleveland Browns to move this year.

rather Kyle play 30 minutes a game and not 36.

"But with the injuries, we can't get Kyle time on the bench and when he gets tired, he really struggles. We have to be able to rest him whether it be a minute or two minutes, and we haven't been able to do that."

In the A&M media guide, Kessel lists his ultimate goal in basketball is to make A&M a big-time basketball program. The 6-foot guard believes the Aggies are on the right track.

"I had hoped we would win more games, but I think we're going to be really good down the line," Kessel said.

"Next year, we have some big-time players coming in and I think they'll help fill some holes.

"We already have some great players on our team right now who I think will get. I'm really excited to see how we'll do in the Big 12."

On the baseball front, Kessel was drafted by the Mets in the 1994 Amateur baseball draft. Although he signed a professional contract, Kessel is allowed to compete in basketball as a non-scholarship player.

Playing on a pair of Mets' rookie league teams last summer, Kessel compiled a 7-0 record with a 1.80 ERA. Unleashing a 92-mph fastball, the lefthander struck out 70 batters in 70 innings of work.

Kessel said he hopes to continue to play professional baseball after he graduates from A&M.

"I'm going to play again next summer and see how things go, and then come back to school," Kessel said. "Hopefully after I finish school, I can keep playing baseball."
