# \* VICTOR VICTORIOUS \* Morales moving campaign out of kitchen

The Democratic Senate nominee has driven himself tens of thousands of miles around Texas in his pickup, with his wife serving as campaign treasurer and his kitchen as campaign central. He's got \$9,000 in the bank, compared with Republican opponent Phil Gramm's \$3.5 million.

AUSTIN (AP) — Democratic Senate nominee Victor Morales says he can stand the political eat, but he can't wait to move his ampaign out of his kitchen.

"I don't know how long it's going to take me to get a headquarters, but ... that's a priority. I want that phone out of my house. want the papers out of my house," Morales said Wednesday, a day after winning his party's nod to face Republican U.S. Sen. Phil Gramm.

The Dallas-area high school government teacher, who took a leave of absence from his job to campaign, has already bested two Democratic congressmen in his shoestring effort.

U.S. Rep. Jim Chapman was eliminated in the primary. In the runoff, Morales beat U.S. Rep. John Bryant, despite Bryant's support from such Democratic heavyweights as former Gov. Ann Richards.

Morales has driven himself tens of thousands of miles around Texas in his pickup, with his wife serving as campaign treasurer and
