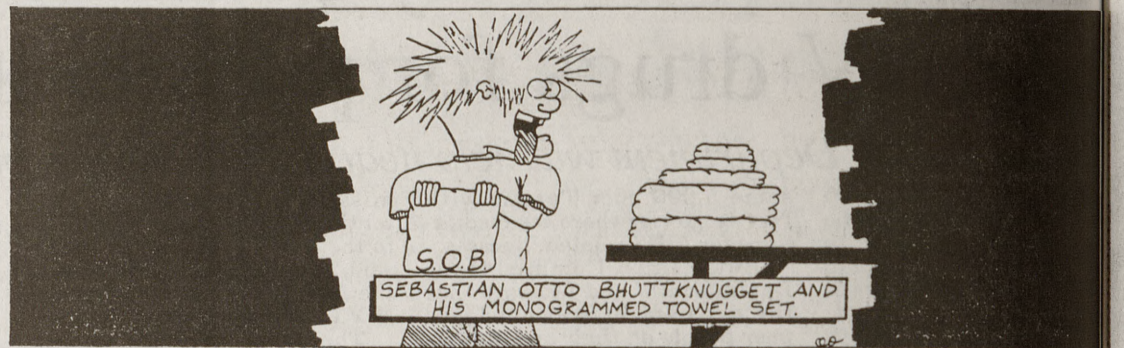


MAY GRADS
