

Time is running out for the producers to contact the county about putting on the festival. The Mass Gathering Act of Texas requires a permit for events attracting large crowds so health, safety and law enforcement arrangements can be made.

The request for such a permit must be made 45 days before the event takes place. This leaves the producers of the festival only ten days to submit their application. A new rumor around town is that the producers will apply

for a permit in Austin. A spokesman for Pace Concerts, which was originally responsible for bringing Lollapalooza to College Station, said a move to Austin is possible and that all dates are unconfirmed.
