

Lasorda retires after 4 years with Dodgers



LOS ANGELES (AP) — Tom Lasorda, an ambassador and cheerleader for baseball for nearly two decades, retired today as manager of the Los Angeles Dodgers after having heart surgery last month.

Lasorda, 68, underwent the angioplasty procedure when it was determined he had a heart attack. He said was cleared medically to return, but realized it made sense to retire.

"For me to get into a uniform again — as excitable as I am — I could not continue," Lasorda, his voice shaking, said at a Dodger Stadium news conference. "I decided it's best for me and the organization to step down. ... That's quite a decision."

He had said as recently as Friday he intended to return. He changed his mind after meeting

with owner Peter O'Malley vice president Fred Claire Friday, then again Sunday.

"It's not the end for me the beginning of a new era," Lasorda, who will take a job


