Ten years ago: A judge in Los Angeles sentenced Cathy Evelyn Smith to three years in prison for involuntary manslaughter in connection with the 1982 drug overdose death of comedian John Belushi.

Five years ago: President Bush formally recognized the independence of the Baltic states of Lithuania,

Latvia and Estonia. In Moscow, the Soviet Congress of People's Deputies opened its first session since the failed coup, taking up proposals aimed at drastically restructuring the country.


