"We came away with more lessons learned than our worst loss record showed," White said. "We learned about coming back and mostly how to get and give over being young. It was definitely a learning experience."

Much of the focus this year was on junior setter Farah Mensik who is filling the shoes of the departed Suzy Wente, A&M's career assists leader (5,511) and key leader for last year's team.

"I think it is always the case when you have a new setter developing the confidence between the hitters and the setter," Corbelli said. "The timing is very intricate. It's just a matter of time before (Mensik) becomes comfortable. She's a great competitor and she's capable of being a great leader."

Mensik was impressive in her first year, recording 166 assists in the game tournament. Her 72 assists in the match against Loyola Marymount tied Suzy Wente's record in the A&M record book.

White said Mensik has the leadership abilities needed in a setter. "She's one of those natural leaders," White said. "She's been consistent and pulled through in every tough situation."

Mensik said she will not shy away from the pressure of being one of the primary leaders of the team.

"It's very important for me to play the leadership roles for my team," Mensik said. "No matter how bad we do, I have to be there for them. I take the blame and try to (keep things) positive."

White and junior setter VanderWoude, both returning starters, will keep the middle blocker position strong. White played in all 109 games last year and was named to the All-District team and first team All-SWC. VanderWoude played in 10 games, averaging a team-leading 1.20 blocks per game.

The outside hitters are sophomore Stacy Sykora, junior Brian Polak and returning junior starter Kristie Smedsrud.

Smedsrud was named to the team All-District and All-SWC last year and led the team in ace average (0.44), kill average (3.80) and dig average (2.76).

Mensik said with the talent they have, the Lady Aggies need to develop more as a complete team in order to succeed.

"We made a goal to go farther than we did last year," Mensik said. "I think we can beat (Nebraska and Texas). Everybody is beatable. It's very reasonable that we can win the conference."
