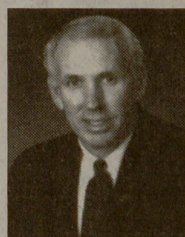

"Maybe it can be an awakening for us," Mitchell said. "This is going to really make us dig deep and see what type of players we do have and what we want out of this season. This may be good for us to go back and get it going."
