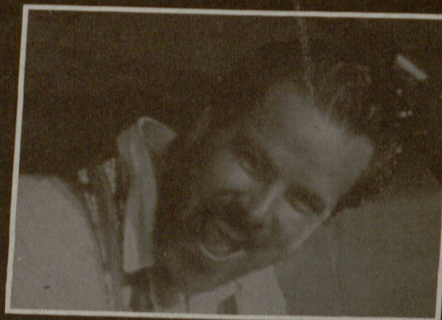

Any increase in the prime rate may take the form of higher payments.

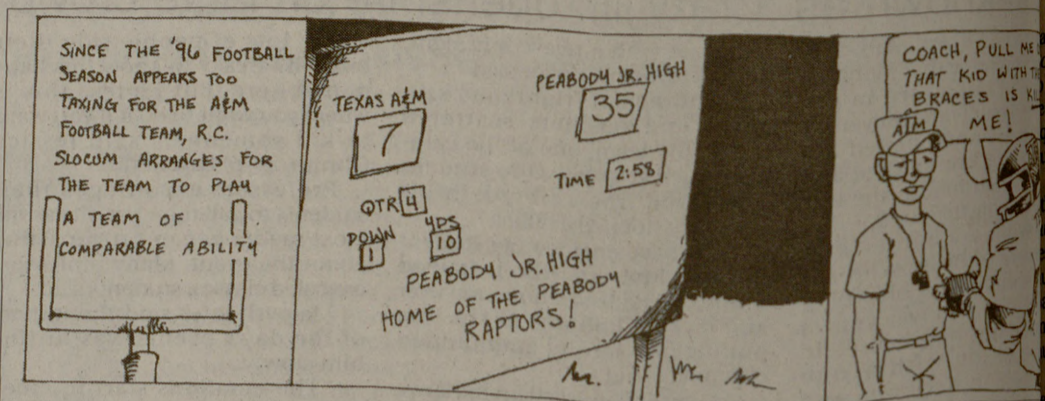

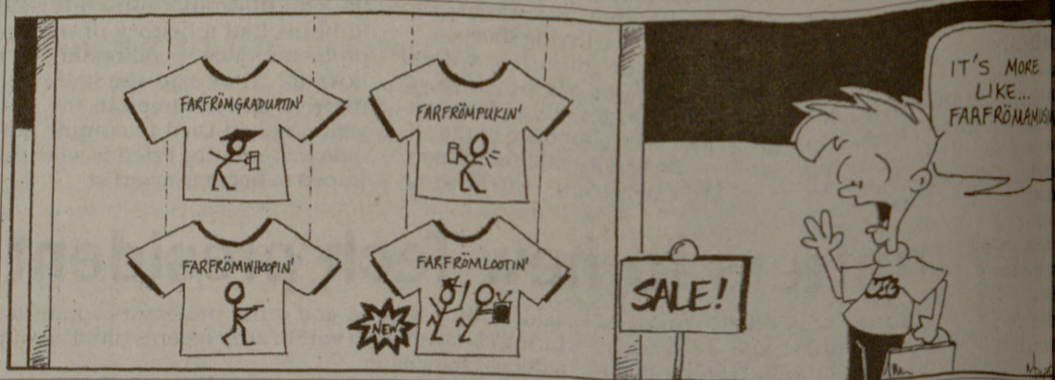

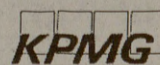
