"My cousin John did tie the knot yesterday," Rep. Patrick Kennedy, D-R.I., confirmed Sunday morning at a fund-raiser for congressional candidate Robert Burch in Steubenville, Ohio. He gave no details, including the name of the bride.

Kennedy has been romantically linked for about five years to Carolyn Bessette, who works in public relations for Calvin Klein Ltd. in New York City.


