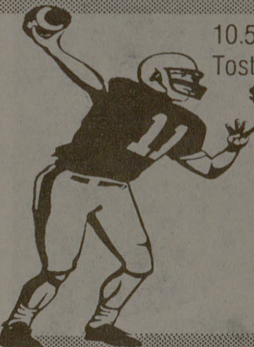

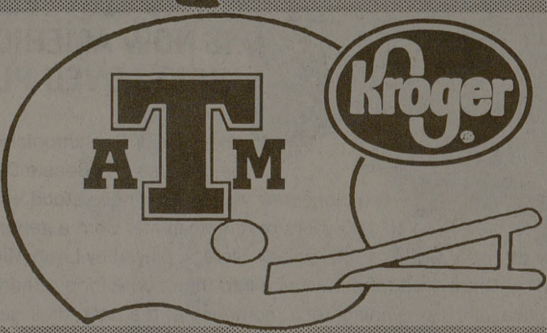

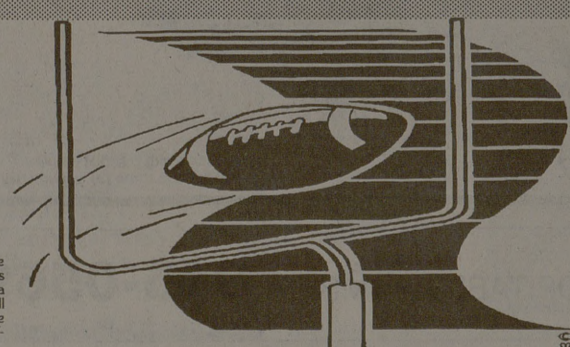

*The Long Kiss Goodnight*

Samuel L. Jackson is Mitch Henderson, a low-budget detective who joins Samantha/Charly on her journey to find out the truth.

Throughout the film, he delivers cleverly placed one-liners, leaving the audience in great upheavals of laughter.

Davis, on the other hand, seems to be America's first female action star.

She gives a meaty, hard-core edge to the character of Charly, and when Samantha returns, she reverts to being practical and motherly.

Renny Harlin, director of the film, has a hit on his hands.

As Davis' husband, Harlin had a rough time coping with the failure of directing his wife's pirate feature, *Cutthroat Island*.

But now, the success he achieved with *Cliffhanger* and *Die Hard* has returned.

Davis and Jackson have an onscreen chemistry that is undeniable, and the film never gives the audience a dull moment.

*The Long Kiss Goodnight* delivers just what an audience wants — good acting, dazzling action sequences and an ending that satisfies. A-
