NEW YORK (AP) — The Greg Maddux was pitching on a roll Monday night, as he shut out the Yankees in the second game of the postseason, a 5-0 win. The Atlanta Braves didn't need to go on another rampage, but instead on Maddux's eight shutout innings to beat the New York Yankees 4-0 Monday night for the lead in the World Series.

Fred McGriff drove in three as the Braves won their fifth game in the postseason, a 5-0 win which they've outscored opponent 48-2. On this night, though, Maddux put the focus right back on Atlanta's awesome starters. The win moved the defending champions halfway toward the title, and sent the Series to Atlanta for the next three games, if all three are necessary.

Bengal's Shula replaced by Coslet

CINCINNATI (AP) — Dave Shula who had his father's prominent nose but not his knack for winning, was fired today as the Cincinnati Bengals' head coach. Offensive coordinator Brian Coslet will coach the team for the rest of the season and have the opportunity to stay longer if both teams win.

"I've asked Dave to step aside as head coach. That's a hard thing for me to do," general manager Mike Brown told a news conference. "He's good people, works hard ... He just didn't get the job done. In this game, in this business, you have to do that." Shula is the first NFL coach to lose his job this season. "I wish Bruce Coslet and the Bengals all the luck in the world," said Shula, who stood with Brown before reporters. "I thank Mike for the patience he's shown throughout the years, as we've struggled to put a winner on the field. The record is what I'm judged on. That obviously was not adequate."

He is concentrating on playing the A&M team, improving his game, and sticking to what has helped him get where he is.
