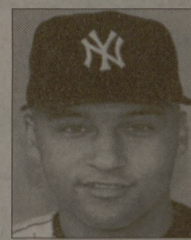

Jeter unanimously named 1996 AL Rookie of Year

NEW YORK (AP) — Derek Jeter, who began the season as the second-most publicized shortstop in New York and blossomed into one of baseball's best young players, unanimously won the AL Rookie of the Year award Monday.

Jeter batted .314 with 10 home runs and 78 RBIs in the regular season, then helped the Yankees win the World Series just four months after his 22nd birthday.

Jeter was the eighth Yankee player to win the award — including shortstops Tony Kubek and Tresh — and the first since Dan Righetti in 1981. He received all first-place votes and 140 points balloting by the Baseball Writers Association of America.

Chicago White Sox pitcher James Baldwin, who went 11-10 with 19 second-place votes and points. Detroit first baseman Tony Clark, who hit 27 home runs, was third with six second-place votes and 64 points. Jeter was the fifth unanimous choice for the award and the first since California outfielder Salmon in 1993.

Trying to stay focused, Ibanez said before each game she kneels to pray and relax herself.

"I don't like to get too nervous," Ibanez said. "I like to joke around in the locker room and just enjoy the atmosphere of the game."

Enjoying her "dream season" with the sixth-ranked A&M team, Ibanez finds motivation in her teammates and their success. Facing the Big 12 Conference Championships this weekend in St. Louis, Mo., Ibanez said she hopes to touch up on flaws during practice this week.

"I've really tried to take [the season] game-by-game, step-by-step," Ibanez said. "For the first time, we are the team to beat and we are pretty established. We now have a reputation to uphold and have to win."

To make game situations easier for her teammates, Ibanez said she tries to play to people's feet and to provide help across the whole field.

"Sonia is one of the best players in the country," Guerrieri said. "She is skillful and aggressive and really uses her own strength to be a team strength."

Her most memorable moment in soccer shows her aggressive nature.
