improve communication between student delegates and the regents and to promote student con-
cenns. He said the regents' practice cerns. He said the regents' practice of meeting at

"Rotating the meetings allows more students to attend and give their inputi" Golden said
Golden said the board disagres with Ogden's proposal to consolidate tuition and fees into three main categories. He said consolidating fees would lead to confusion rather than clarification "IOgden's idea) inhibits the ability to track spe-
ciftic allocations,", Golden said. "We need to concentrate on a market-driven tuition."
He said market-driven tuition would help avoid unjust increases in tuition and fees. In other business, the Board approved phase
three of the project to improve Texas A\&M athletic facilities. Phase three is a proposal to
