A&M stays in stroke with No. 2 Tennessee

Entering competition as the underdogs, the Texas A&M Men's Swimming and Diving Teams proved it would not give up without a fight.

The Aggies faced the No. 2 University of Tennessee Volunteers in their tenth dual meet of the season Thursday. After a shaky first half, A&M came back strong, finishing closely behind Tennessee, 129 to 102.

"This was definitely a challenge," A&M Head Men's Swimming Coach Mel Nash said. "It was a major step up for our guys and I am really pleased."

A&M produced impressive times in two challenging races in the last events. Freshman Matt Rice finished in first place in the 200-meter breaststroke with a time of 2:06.74. The A&M relay team, consisting of sophomores Jerrod Kappler and Ryan Slater and freshmen Michael Colligan and Keven Kehlenback, gained 11 points for the Aggies in the 200-meter freestyle relay with a first place finish at 1:22.80.

The diving team had successes of its own. Sophomore Mark Naftanel finished first in both diving events — the one-meter and three-meter competitions. "Mark had a great day," A&M Head Diving Coach Kevin Wright said. "He's only a sopho-

more and going against seniors. He really stayed with himself and it's so important when talent level increases, keep composure like that."

Facing some of its toughest competition of the season, Nash said the team hopes to maintain the momentum from the second half of the meet against Tennessee into future meets against teams such as the University of Texas at Southern Methodist University.

"This is a different situation going against such good teams such as Kansas and Nebraska, upsets are rare," Nash said. "I know going in that it will be a little bit of an uphill climb. Tennessee is very well-balanced and very well coached, but we swam tough tough swims."

Finishing second in the 200-meter butterfly, freshman Devin Howard came close to a win with his time of 1:50.85, while Tennessee senior Falt Fleischmann finished first at 1:49.98. Likewise, senior Rob Pantano finished just over a second behind junior Sean Stringer of Tennessee in the 200-meter backstroke with a time of 1:49.74.

"We're learning that these top ranked teams are human," Nash said. "We may not beat them every time but we can swim with them."

A&M's dual meet record now stands at 6-4 as they prepare to face the University of Tennessee next Saturday.

Lady Aggies to fight losing streak and OSU

The Texas A&M Women's Basketball Team (6-7, 0-3) will look to get back on the winning road when it welcomes the Oklahoma State Cowgirls (10-3, 2-1) to G. Rolle White Coliseum Saturday at 7 p.m.

A&M Head Coach Candi Harvey said the Lady Aggies, who have lost five straight, have been encouraged by their play over the last few games and are primed for a breakout performance.

Harvey said the team has shown flashes of brilliance at times but was not able to put together two consistent halves. "If we can put two halves together, even as young as we are, as little as we are, with all
