

Texas A&M Women's Basketball Team escaped with a 75-72 victory over Oklahoma State University on Saturday night. A&M's first ever Big 12 win ended a three game losing streak

At 7-8 overall, 1-4 in the Big 12, Head Coach Candi Harvey said she is looking for consistent improvement from the team, while building momentum going into the conference tournament

Tucker on the Doorstep of the 1,000-Point Club

Senior guard Lana Tucker needs just 16 more points to enter the 1,000-point club. The team captain, who is averaging 14.3 points per game, is on track to accomplish the feat against either the University of Kansas (Jan. 22) or Kansas State University (Jan. 25). If Tucker exceeds the 1,000-point mark, she will become only the 12th player in A&M history to do so. She would join former teammates Lisa Branch (1,939, No. 1) and Martha McClelland (1,001, No.11) in the elite club.

En Fuego from the Charity Stripe

The Lady Aggies are taking advantage of their opportunities from the charity stripe this season. Completing 302-of-438 (.689) attempts from the freethrow line, the Lady Aggies rank third in the Big 12 behind the University of Texas (.720) and Iowa State University (.698). A&M's top free throw game was against the University of Dartmouth (20-of-25, .800).

Last year, the Aggies fin-ished 22nd at the NCAA national meet with 44 points. Nash said he hopes that this year the team will end up in the top 20, because of their added strength and depth.
