

Cosby show draws high Nielsen ratings

NEW YORK (AP) — The "Cosby" show drew its fourth-highest rating of the season in its first airing since the slaying of Bill Cosby's son, CBS said.

Reports from Nielsen Media Research's top markets showed that "Cosby" had a 12.7 rating and attracted 20 percent of the audience watching television at the time Monday night.

The week before, Cosby had an 11.4 rating and a 17 share, CBS said

CBS opened and closed Monday night's episode with a tribute to Ennis Cosby. A picture of Cosby's son flashed at the end with the message,

'my hero, my son.' In the episode, Cosby's character tried to win a million-dollar prize by shooting a basket from half court. An episode about crime in the character's neighborhood was original-
