The late Tupac Shakur investigates 'a world of sin' on thoughtful, creative final release not ran

the don killuminati: the 7 day theory Death Row Records

In the height of the controversy surrounding Tupac Shakur's murder, his newest album (released under the alias Makaveli) may be his

strongest work ever. The don killuminati: the 7 day theory is creative and original.

The most noticeable thing about the music is the lack of drums and drum machines. Drums have been replaced with stronger bass lines, pianos, organs, rhythmic hand claps and other percussion.

Much of the rap that has been released is little more than someone rhyming over a drum machine and keyboard. Therefore, Makaveli's use of real instruments makes the album fresh and different enough to

Tracks like "life of an outlaw," "white man'z world" and "me and my girlfriend" are laced with the sounds of a classical, almost mariachi, guitar that is rarely used in rap music.

Makaveli also uses quirky, offbeat piano-playing to spice up the album in songs like "bomb first (my second reply)," "just like daddy," "krazy," "hold ya head" and "against all odds."

In fact, the only song that is close to being unoriginal is "toss it up," because of the similarities to Black Street's "No Diggity."

With help from JoJo and KC from the soul group Jodeci, Makaveli makes "toss it up" the song that Black Street was attempting to write. KC and JoJo give the background a smooth R&B sound which, when combined with Makaveli's perfect voice, create a song conducive to some serious lounging.


Although the music behind the don killuminati makes the album a step forward in the maturing of rap music, it is truly the lyrics that make this album a work of art.

This may be the first rap album to truly uncover the artistic and philosophical importance of the American ghetto's voice. The aim of the album is to raise the philosophical question of evil and provide a viable solution for it.

Makaveli sees his world as full of sin ("me and my girlfriend") and murder, money and power ("intro"). His family tree "consists of drug dealers, thugs, and killers" ("blasphemy").

Given his many imperfections, the aims of Makaveli's album are to believe in heaven, and to enter it, although he has already seen hell.

"Is God just another cop waiting to beat my ass if I don't go pop?

Is heaven just another door?" he wonders in the highly intellectual song "blasphemy.

Not only does the album raise questions, it offers possible solutions. In "me and my girlfriend," Makaveli sings, "All I need in this life

of sin is me and my girlfriend." Maybe it is up to us to take away each other's pain, or as Makaveli puts it, "I'm looking out for you just

Or maybe Makaveli sho member what his pops t ("blasphemy"). Maybe he shi follow his elder's footsteps happiness in the Lord.

No one knows, not Makaveli, but anyone whose ly listens to the don killum 7 day theory will see that hema on the right track.
