Gilbert Schorlemmer, a student worker in the financial aid office and a political science and economics major, said VOCOM should alleviate some of the frustration in the financial aid office.

The lines are avoided," Schorlemmer said. "You come here (financial aid office) and you used to have to wait in long lines."

Schorlemmer said the only drawback of VOCOM is its tie to the phone registration system. During peak registration hours, VOCOM could be inaccessible to


some students, he said. Lawson said students sh use VOCOM to help correct po
