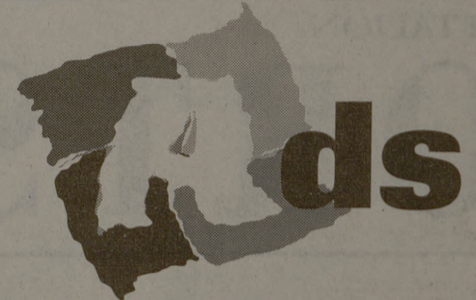

AGGIE RING ORDERS

THE ASSOCIATION OF FORMER STUDENTS CLAYTON W. WILLIAMS, JR. ALUMNI CENTER

DEADLINE: February 12, 1997

Undergraduate Student Requirements:

- You must be a degree seeking student and have a total of 95 credit hours reflected on Texas A&M University Student Information Management System. (A passed course, if repeated and passed, cannot count as additional credit hours.)
- 30 credit hours must have been completed in residence at Texas A&M University, provided prior to January 1, 1994, you were registered at Texas A&M University and successfully completed a fall/spring semester or summer term (I and II) or 10 weeks as a full-time student in standing (as defined in the University catalog).
- 60 credit hours must have been completed in residence at Texas A&M University if you semester at Texas A&M University was January 1994 or thereafter, or if you do not qualify for the successful semester requirement. Should your degree be conferred with less than 60 credit hours, this requirement will be waived after your degree is posted on the Student Information Management System.
- You must have a 2.0 cumulative GPR at Texas A&M University.
- You must be in good standing with the University, including no registration or transcript block for past due fees, loans, parking tickets, returned checks, etc.

Graduate Student Requirements

If you are a May 1997 degree candidate and you do not have an Aggie ring from a prior degree, you may place an order after you meet the following requirements:

- Your degree is conferred and posted on the Texas A&M University Student Information Management System; and
- You are in good standing with the University, including no registration or transcript block for past due fees, loans, parking tickets, returned checks, etc.

If you have completed all of your degree requirements and can obtain a "Letter of Completion" from the Office of Graduate Studies, the original letter of completion, with the seal, must be presented to the Ring Office in lieu of your degree being posted.

Procedure To Order A Ring:

- If you meet all of the above requirements, you must visit the Ring Office no later than Wednesday, February 12, 1997 to complete the application for eligibility verification.
- If your application is approved and you wish to receive your ring on April 22, 1997, you must return and pay in full by cash, check, money order, or your personal MasterCard (with your name imprinted) no later than February 14, 1997.
