### ► This day in history

Today is Friday, Feb. 21, the 52nd day of 1997. There prison for their roles in the Watergate coveru are 313 days left in the year.

In 1846, Sarah G. Bagley became the first female telegrapher as she took charge at the newly opened telegraph office in Lowell, Mass.

In 1866, Lucy B. Hobbs became the first woman to graduate from a dental school, the Ohio College of Dental Surgery in Cincinnati.

In 1878, the first telephone directory was issued, by the District Telephone Company of New Haven, Conn.

In 1885, the Washington Monument was dedicated. In 1916, the World War I Battle of Verdun began in France.

In 1925, The New Yorker magazine made its debut. In 1947, Edwin H. Land publicly demonstrated his Polaroid Land camera, which could produce a blackand-white photograph in 60 seconds

In 1965, former Black Muslim leader Malcolm X was shot and killed by assassins identified as Black Muslims as he was about to address a rally in New York City; he was 39.

In 1972, President Nixon began his historic visit to China.

In 1973, Israeli fighter planes shot down a Libyan Airlines jet over the Sinai Desert, killing more than 100 people.

In 1975, former Attorney General John N. Mitchell and former White House aides H.R. Haldeman and John D. Ehrlichman were sentenced to 2 1/2 to 8 years in


