Fysher has gained acclaim for the strength of its original songs. The band has about 15 originals in its repertoire.

"Right now, we don't write together," Buckley said. "One of us comes up with an idea, and it's the bare backbone of the song."

"Personally, I love our songs," Beadle said. "My personal goal is to make a song out of a Shakespearean sonnet."

The band plays the occasional cover, but avoids more well-known songs, Buckley said.

"The covers we do aren't mainstream," he said. "Most are totally obscure."

Fysher's name came from a suggestion by an acquaintance of the band, Buckley said.

"We racked our brains together, but everything just sounded stupid," he said. "Finally, our friend came up with 'Fysher', and we couldn't come up with any reason why it was a bad name. It didn't say anything about us, and we like to let our music speak for itself."

"It's not obvious," Smashing Pumpkins said.

"Like 'Deathhole' or something," he said. "The quick popularity of the band has encouraged the band members, Beadle said."

"The crowd interaction is the best," he said. "I wouldn't trade that for anything I've done."

Fysher hopes to increase its ready-made fan base, Montoya said. "You have to come hear us get into it."

"Good," Buckley said. "You play it."

**First Grammy surprises First Lady**

NEW YORK (AP) — Now she is the first lady AND a Grammy winner.

Hillary Rodham Clinton's book on child rearing, "It Takes a Village," took the award for best spoken word or nonmusical album. The book spent 20 weeks on best-seller lists last year.

Clinton, seemingly out of place among musicians like Smashing Pumpkins and Celine Dion, found out she was a winner more than two hours before the televised ceremony of the 39th annual Grammy Awards began.

"I was very surprised because I didn't even know the Grammys were given to deaf people like Clinton said at a news conference backstage."
