"He missed last year by only one vote, and only by a couple before that," said veterans committee member Yogi Berra, a Hall of Fame himself. "The guy played in 150 games or more over 18 years That's remarkable."

In 1985, 10 years after his death from cancer at age 47, Fox finished two votes shy of election — the slimmest margin in the shrine's histo ry - in the balloting by the Baseba Writers Association of America.
