Becki Elkins-Nesheim, coordinator of the Women's Program in the Department of Student Life and organizer of tonight's Take Back the Night Rally, said people do not really talk about violence in dating relationships. "Hopefully we can bring awareness about the issue of date rape," Elkins-Nesheim said.

The A&M chapter of the National

Organization of Women (NOW) also is sponsoring tonight's rally.

Crissy Gonzalez, vice president of the organization and a senior sociology major, said the problem of date rape at A&M is bigger than people think.

"It is a combination of covering up the problem and not publicizing that there is a problem," Gonzalez said.

She said tonight's rally aims to bring about awareness.

"It is for the people who don't realize that they know people who have been assaulted," Gonzalez said. "It is

kind of a prevention and awareness."

Castoria said the main reason women do not report rape is a feeling of fear.

"There is a feeling of being partly responsible," Castoria said. "All survivors feel this way. There is a myth that women are responsible and should be able to prevent it, but men are responsible as well."

Wiatt said while the police cannot force women to come forward, they do encourage them to report rapes.

"There are a lot more date rapes

on campus, but we would like (about) more if people reported," Wiatt said.

Larson said women must be more careful and realize being an Aggie does not make one immune to dangers.

"This is a big university, with a lot of people who go in and out of town," Larson said. "You kind of have to be careful of who they take rides from. It is a sad thing that they don't report — it just makes the situation worse."
