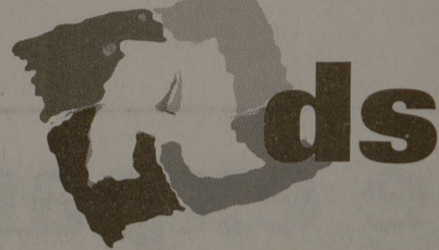

## Rangers slide by Indians

CLEVELAND (AP) — Wade Newson hit two of Texas' solo home runs and the Rangers beat Cleveland 7-6 Sunday.

Rusty Greer, Juan Gonzalez and Lee Stevens also hit home runs for the Rangers. Brian Clark and David Justice homered for Cleveland.
