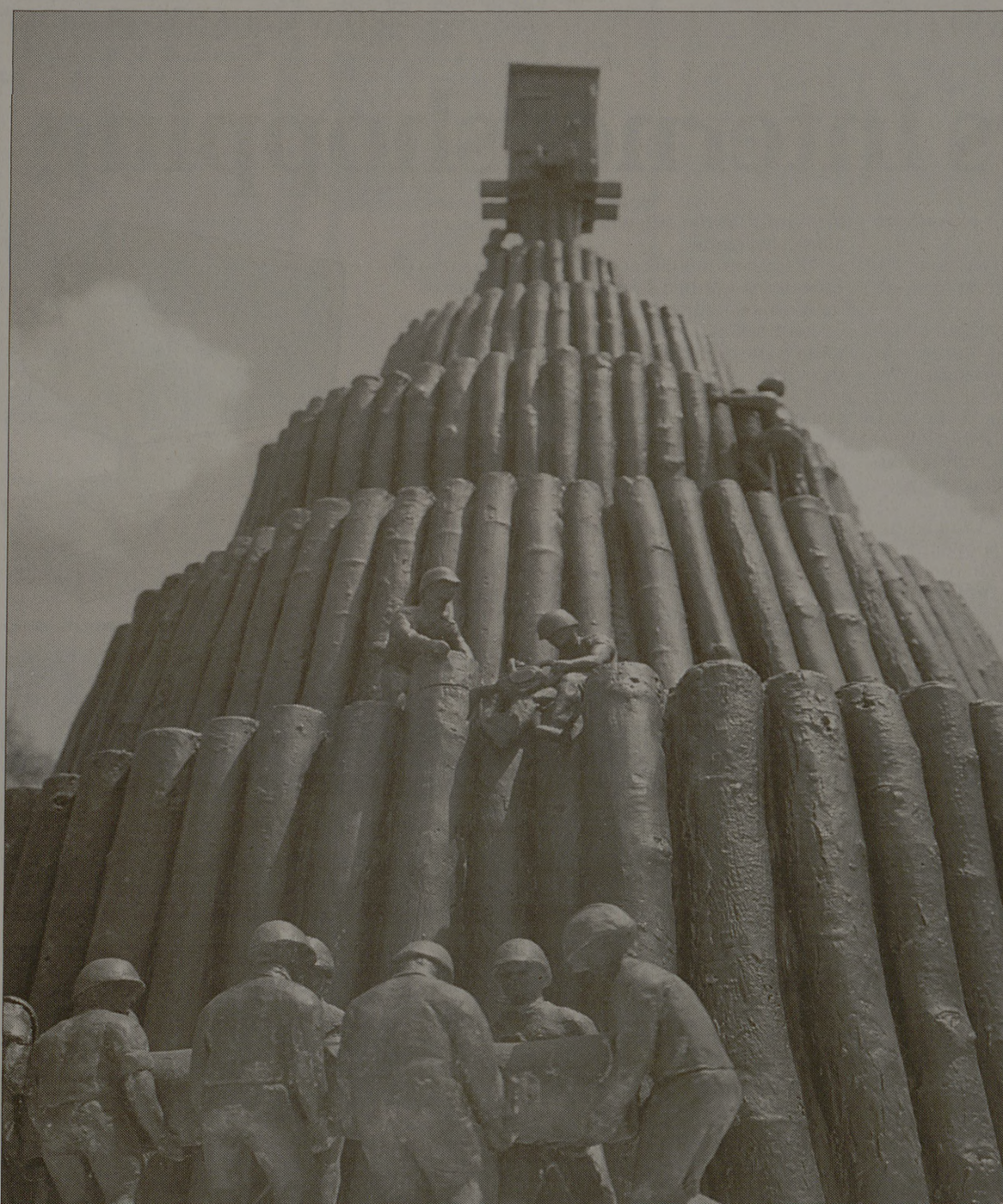


A gift that stacks up
