Previously, Res Net installations have been comleted only in non-occuppied residence halls during the summer to keep the disturbance of residents to a minimum, McCauley said.

Dan Mizer, assistant director in Residence Life, said he expects the department to meet with campus leaders within the next two weeks to discuss the possibility of construction being done during the fall and spring semesters.

Due in part to the completion of installations during the summer, Texas A&M will be able to make all necessary installations for \$1.6 million, about onethird of the expected cost.
