Prime Time becomes fulltime Agg Reds allow Sanders to join Cowboys on permanent basis

CINCINNATI (AP) — The Cincinnati Reds have given Deion Sanders permission to end his baseball season after Friday night's game to join the Dallas Cowboys fulltime.

The deal takes effect after the final out is made in the Reds-Pittsburgh Pirates game at Cinergy Field Friday night, The Cincinnati Post and the Dayton Daily News reported today.

It is none too soon for Sanders, 30, who said he has become fatigued by playing two sports and is struggling for time to see his two children.

"This is going to be easier for me. I'm not a

spring chicken anymore. It used to be cute in Atlanta, leaving in a helicopter and everything, but it's not cute any more,' Sanders said, referring to his previous twosport days with the Atlanta Braves and Atlanta Falcons.

Sanders agreed with Reds' general man-

ager Jim Bowden on Wednesday that he will stay with the team through Friday, fly to Dallas on Cowboys owner Jerry Jones' private jet after the game and then devote all of his attention to the Cowboys starting Saturday

"I basically told him to forget what the contract says," Bowden said. "We respect that he's one of the best football players in the country and we made it clear that we don't want him to stay here out of loyalty toward myself or the organization. He has to do what's right for both sports."


