

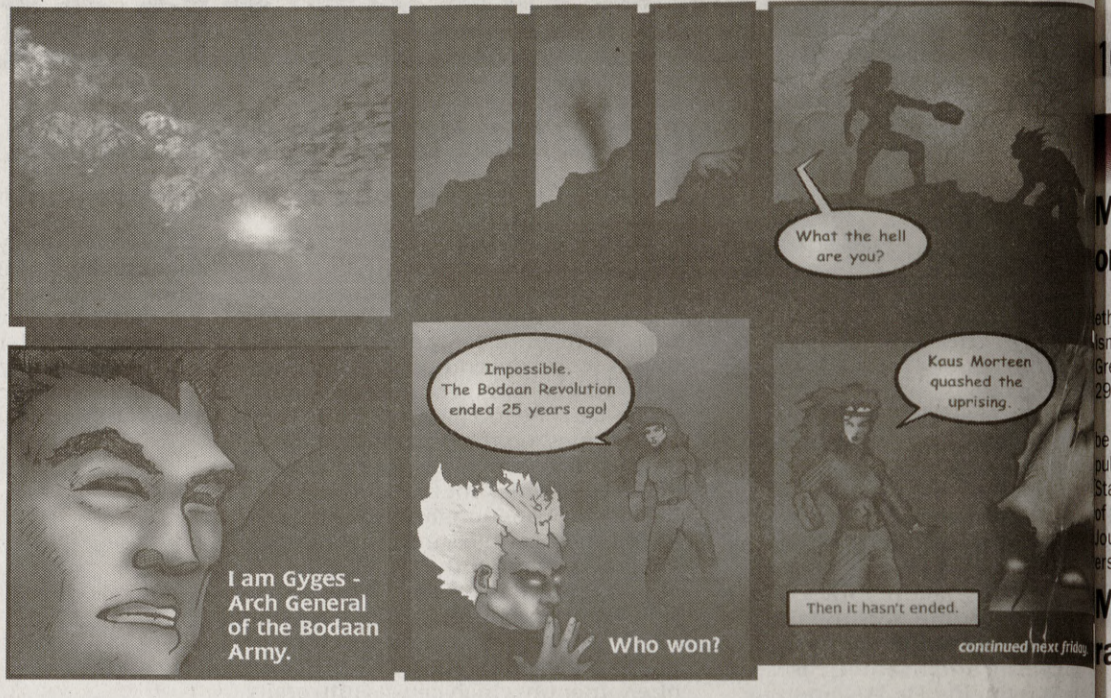

Ricardo Gonzalez, coordinator of Admission Services, encouraged A&M volunteers to help recruit potential students at events such as Aggie Kickoff, which brought more
