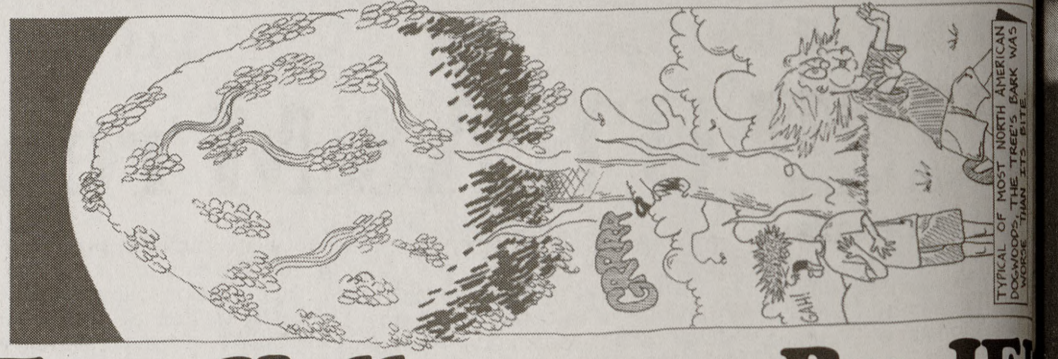


**Making sparks**



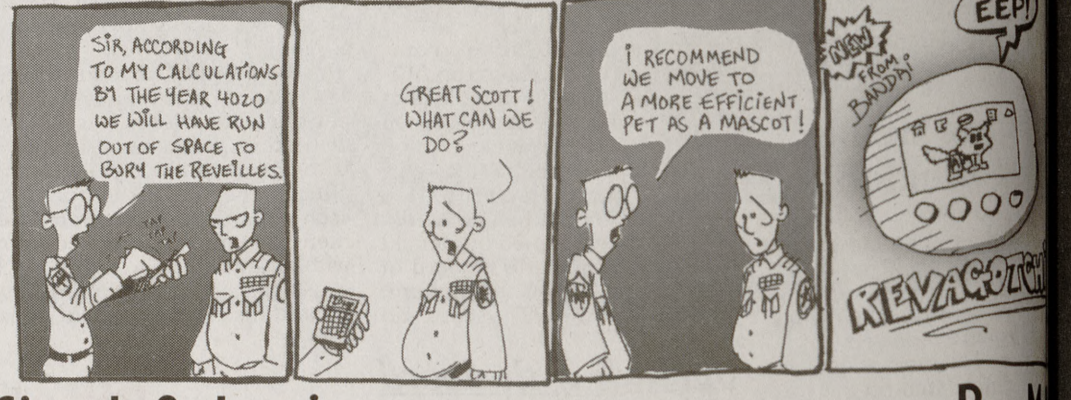

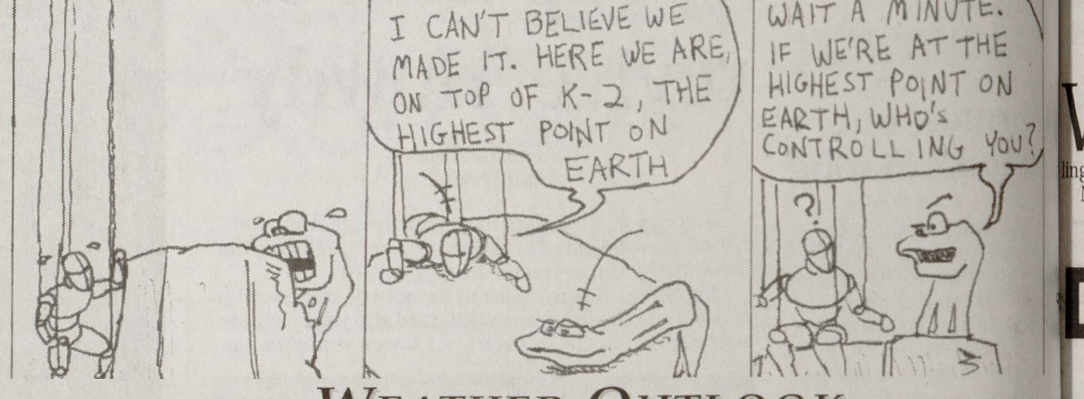
