Dedication, motivation and endurance are three things Millie Ondras, team captain of the Texas A&M Cross Country Team, says she possesses. Ondras, a senior English major from San Antonio, has run 50-to-70 miles a week for the past seven years. She attributes her talent to a lot of hard work.

With a relatively young team this year, she as well as her teammates are working hard to make Texas A&M one of the top programs in the Big 12.

Team Most Valuable Player in 1996, Ondras said her biggest influence is her boyfriend James Mence, who is also a member of the cross country team.

"He is my biggest supporter and he gives me a lot of advice," she said.


Ondras runs the 5K and 10K distances. She likes the longer distances better because it presents more of a challenge for her. It also takes a lot of self-motivation to push herself to the limit everyday. The training is very hard and strenuous on the body but Ondras doesn't mind the effort.

"I have been running for so long that it doesn't seem difficult to me," Ondras said. "It has to be something that you like to do."

Many people do not have the drive to put themselves through the harsh training it takes to become a cross country runner. It takes a focused person to be able to withstand the toll that training can take on the body. Ondras has stayed virtually injury free. She has not missed a race in the four years she has been on the cross country team.

Cross country coach Greg Hinze said that Ondras has probably improved the most considering where she came from and where she is right now as a result of her hard work and dedication.

"If things were to go right for Millie this year, she could qualify for the NCAA Cross Country

Championships," he said. A lot of the skills Ondras possesses were developed in school. She was very close to coach and teammates.

"The experience left a lasting impression on her. She feels the training she had back then helped her to become a better athlete today."

"She works harder than anyone on the team," Hinze said.

Ondras said she is her role model.

"It doesn't matter what people do because I am still going to be me," she said.

Hinze said she provides comic relief for the team.

"No matter how bad things get, she can always put smiles on people's faces," he said.

Ondras admits she has to go on road trips because she hates leaving her cat, Kip, behind. Ondras jokingly confided to sneaking her cat, named after famous Kenyan runner, in her suitcase and taking him on their road trips.

All in all, Ondras loves sport any time soon. After she graduates, she plans to start training for Boston Marathon, but her ultimate goal is to qualify for the Olympics.

McGwire keeps on slugging, hits 53rd home run

CHICAGO (AP) — Mark McGwire hit his 53rd home run of the season Wednesday — the most since Roger Maris set the record of 61 in 1961 — as the St. Louis Cardinals defeated the Chicago Cubs 12-9.

McGwire connected leading off the third inning for his second homer since signing a three-year, \$28.5 million contract with the Cardinals Tuesday night. The 53 homers tops his previous best of 52, which he hit

last season with Oakland, but put McGwire one ahead of Seattle's Ken Griffey Jr., who was to play
