Time running out for McGwire, Griffe

(AP) — Mark McGwire and author of the slugger's biographic Ken Griffey Jr. are providing "I got some hits and hit baseball with a riveting exclamation point to the season - chasing home runs, history and, by the way, the calendar.

And baseball, still trying to rebuild its image from the disastrous strike that canceled the 1994 World Series, couldn't be more grateful for the zest the two sluggers have put in a season with precious few pennant races.

Statistics are special in baseball, made more so by history and records that cover almost 100 years. So while Dan Marino's 48 touchdown passes is the NFL season mark, and Wayne Gretzky's 92 goals is the NHL record, they are not remembered nearly as easily as Roger Maris' 61 home runs in 1961.

Entering Thursday's games, McGwire had 53 home runs and Griffey 52, each with an outside shot at Maris' record set 36 years ago. The problem for both is time, a precious com-



modity that is running out for them. With just over a week to play, there may not be enough games for either. After Thursday, McGwire has 10 to play and Griffey nine. As the games dwindle, so do the

opportunities. Hitters grip the bat a little more tightly, and pitchers bear down a little harder. Sluggers have been down this treacherous road before and found out how difficult the task can be. Before Maris chased Babe

Ruth's record of 60 home runs in a season, the closest anyone had come to the mark was 58, achieved by Jimmy Foxx in 1932 and matched by Hank Greenberg in 1938. Foxx had 54 homers with four






