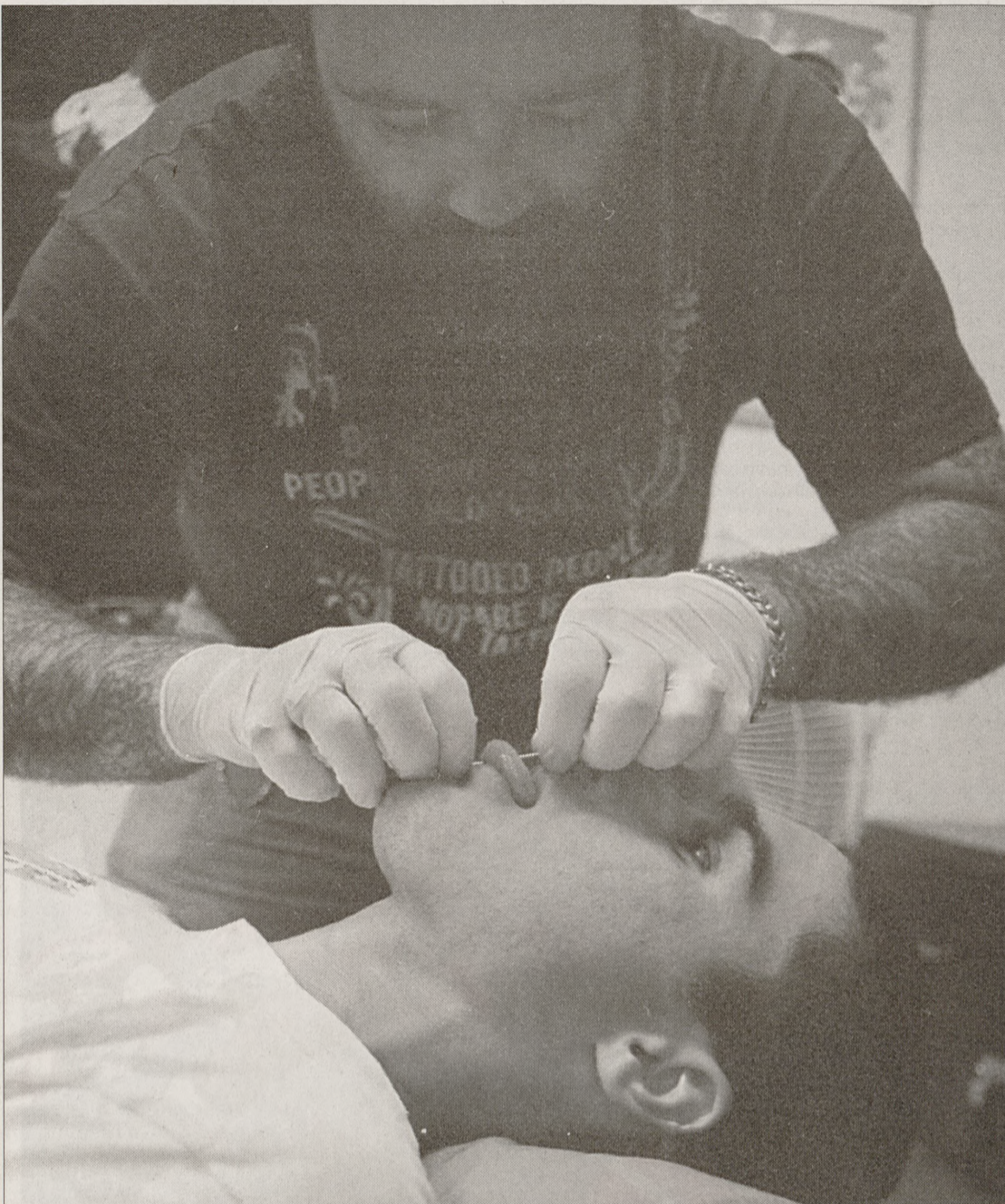


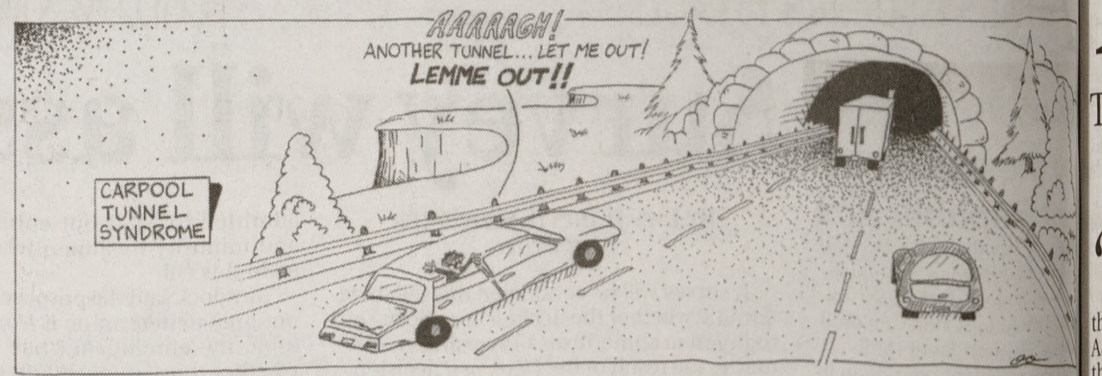

Grant Flores, a freshman mechanical engineering major, gets his tongue pierced by Michael C., class of '85, at a local tattoo shop Saturday evening.

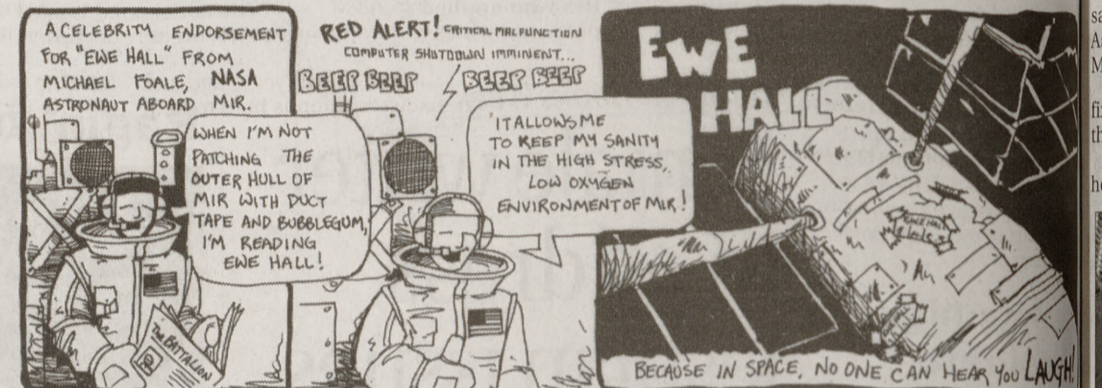
