Aggies prepare for UH

After a successful weekend on the road, the 14th-ranked Texas A&M Volleyball Team returns to College Station to play the Houston Cougars tonight at 7:00 p.m. The Aggies are heading into tonight's game on a major roll. They have won 10 of their last 11 games and are playing a UH team that they beat 3-0 two weeks ago.

"Even though this is not a conference game, we could really use this game to polish ourselves," said junior outside hitter Stacy Sykora. "Houston is a good team. They always give us trouble here at home, so we know we will have to play hard. We want to come away with a win, but we also want to improve on the little things and get some other players more playing time."

The Aggies are an astounding 41-0 under Coach Laura Corbelli in home games against unranked teams. With some teams that kind of home court advantage could lead to overconfidence and a cocky attitude, but that does not seem to be a problem with these Aggies.

"We are not a team that talks trash or gets overconfident," Sykora said. "When two teams are competing, natural tempers become part of the game and things will be said. But we are a team that lets our play do the talking."

UH comes to Aggieland with an 8-5 record and a five game winning streak. Coach Bill Walton,

who is not the obnoxious ball announcer, will be with one of his top players, senior Debbie Vokes. Vokes, who is on the UH career kills list, is with a stress fracture.

This game will be one that help the Ags prepare for the upcoming conference battle. Coach Corbelli is planning to this game to work on blocking, serving, and ball handling.

"Good ball handling is very ical in this game," Corbelli said. "We have always stressed our handling skills, but we have to work so much on our offense defense to become a top team. Our concentration on ball handling has let up and I think showing a little, so we are working on that area of our game."

The Aggies are coming off a to-back 3-1 victories at Baylor. Texas Tech, two games that have been frustrating in the past.

"It's really stressful to play the road," said coach Corbelli. "The teams you play are always their best on their home court because they love the chance to knock off a top team like Aggie. They are just waiting for us to be in their gym. I'm just really proud at how we handled the possibility of having a let down. Volleyball is a game of ups and downs and really stayed together and very focused on what we need to do."

Perhaps, it is the mo' wins have, the mo' problems that come with the territory.
