STAFF AND WIRE Soccer loses to Baylor 2-1 in OT

The No. 3 A&M Soccer Team was stunned by a 2-1 overtime loss to Baylor University, Sunday afternoon, at the rain soaked Baylor Soccer Complex. Baylor's Christina Nguyen received a pass from Britt Talley and scored the Bear's game-winning goal at the 95:20 mark. Baylor's Nikki Hales controversial goal at 23:46 gave the Bears an early 1-0 lead. The ball appeared to have been shot into the outside of the net, but the linesman over-ruled the center officials original call, giving Baylor the advantage. Freshman forward Nicky Thrasher posted the Aggies' lone goal on a pass from freshman midfielder Katie Offutt at the 78:28 mark to send the game into overtime. With the loss, A&M falls to 12-2-0 overall, 8-1-0 in the Big 12. The Aggies can do no worse than tie for the Big 12 Championship, but with a win or a tie versus Colorado in College Station October 26, A&M can win the trophy outright.

A&M ladies place sixth in CC meet

Women's Cross Country placed 21st and sixth respectively Saturday at the Furman Country Course. Milli Ondras finished 32nd, Aggies, completing the three-course with a time of 19:06. Kari Wyatt placed just behind in 33rd with a time of 19:09. "The women ran hard," coach Greg Hinz said in a release. "It was a good experience for them to be here." The Aggie men were James Menze who finished course in 25:57 to finish 75. The two teams will race action next weekend in host Texas A&M Invitational.

The Texas A&M Volleyball team improved its conference record to 1 and its overall record to 6 Saturday as they beat Iowa State in three games, 3-0, 6-15-3. Kristie Smedsrud and Lothspiech led the Aggies and kills each. Stacy Sykora reared team-high 13 digs while Woolsey had three blocks. The Aggies will return to Friday against the University of Colorado in G. Rolfe Coliseum at 7:00 p.m.
