Johnson said he is constantly working on new songs in his head.


"I always have a working satchel of ideas, and I work on them until they become mature," he said. Aside from being a creative out-

Johnson includes a variety of styles in his music, including pop, jazz and blues. He is working on developing his vocal abilities, and he


also plays the piano.
