**Buff's Run Over Cliff**  
After losing for the second consecutive week, Colorado fell out of the Top 25 for the first time since 1988. The Buffaloes are ranked for 143 consecutive second only to Nebraska.  
Colorado Coach Rick Neuheisel said the program is in dire straits. "We are as low as we have been in this program since I arrived in 1994," Neuheisel said. "The guys who stay are going to be glad to get themselves back out of the hole."  
**The Other Ricky Williams**  
Texas Tech freshman running back Ricky Williams rushed for 179 yards leading the Red Raiders past Kansas 17-7. Williams recorded his first 100-yard game as he ran wild through the defense. Williams (of no relation) is the leading rusher in the Big 12 at 408 yards on 86 carries, an average of 4.7 yards per carry.  
**Games of The Week**  
#14 Texas A&M (5-0, 24-17) vs. #23 Kansas State (4-1, 14-15) at KSU Stadium  
This will be the biggest game of the season for the Aggies. The defense, ranked 16th in the nation, will test the Aggies' new nickel-offense passing attack. And Michael Bishop, the Wildcats' athletic director, should give the Wildcats and Crew' fits all afternoon.  
Last year, the Wildcats beat the Aggies 23-20 in a thriller. After spotting Kansas 20-3 halftime lead, the Aggies mounted a spirited second-half comeback in front of 64,153 profic fans. With A&M trailing on third down at the KSU, Albert Connell across the field. The Wildcats' 17-yard line defender, the ball was stripped loose and the Wildcats to seal the win.  
Kansas (4-2, 2-1) at Col (2-3, 0-2) - Folsom Field  
This game could make a difference in the Buffaloes' season. Dropping out of the polls for the first time in nine years after consecutive losses to Big 12 opponents, the Buffaloes are sitting at home during the season. Colorado has just two against Division I-A opponents and need six to qualify for a bowl game.  
The next four games - Kansas, at Texas, Missouri, Iowa State - present the Buffaloes only legitimate path to a national title-contending Cornhuskers.  
But, Kansas is not a cupcake opponent. The Jayhawks are fourth in the Big 12 and 14th nationally in total defense. sputtering Colorado offense have its hands full.
