McCartney receives cheers and jeers at London show

LONDON (AP) — The audience loved Paul McCartney's debut symphony, but the critics weren't quite as enthusiastic.

At the end of the 75-minute orchestral work Tuesday night, cheering fans called the former Beatle up to the stage for six curtain calls.

The symphonic poem, called "Standing Stone," which took McCartney four years to write with help from four collaborators, draws on Celtic roots to tell a story of chaos transformed into order. It was performed by 300 musicians and singers from the London Symphony Orchestra and chorus.

One critic called it superb, but others said it was dull and likely to be quickly forgotten.

A compact disc of the work is currently riding on the U.S. classical charts.

Prince Harry plans South Africa trip to see Spice Girls perform

LONDON (AP) — Britain's Prince Harry will go to Africa with his father Prince Charles next month for a fari and a meeting with the Spice Girls.

Harry, 13, is scheduled to make two public engagements with his father.

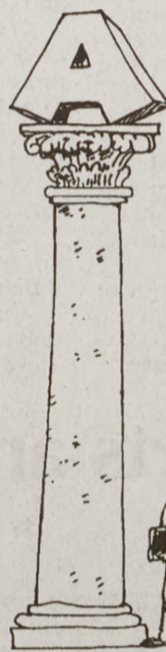
These include a Spice Girls concert at Johannesburg Stadium Nov. 1 and a Nov. 3 visit to the village of Duku Duku.

The two will depart Oct. 22. Prince William will not be able to join his father because his school break will end soon, St. James' Palace said.

The boys returned to their boarding schools last week after the Aug. 31 death of their mother, Princess Diana. They have attempted to remain out of the public eye ever since.

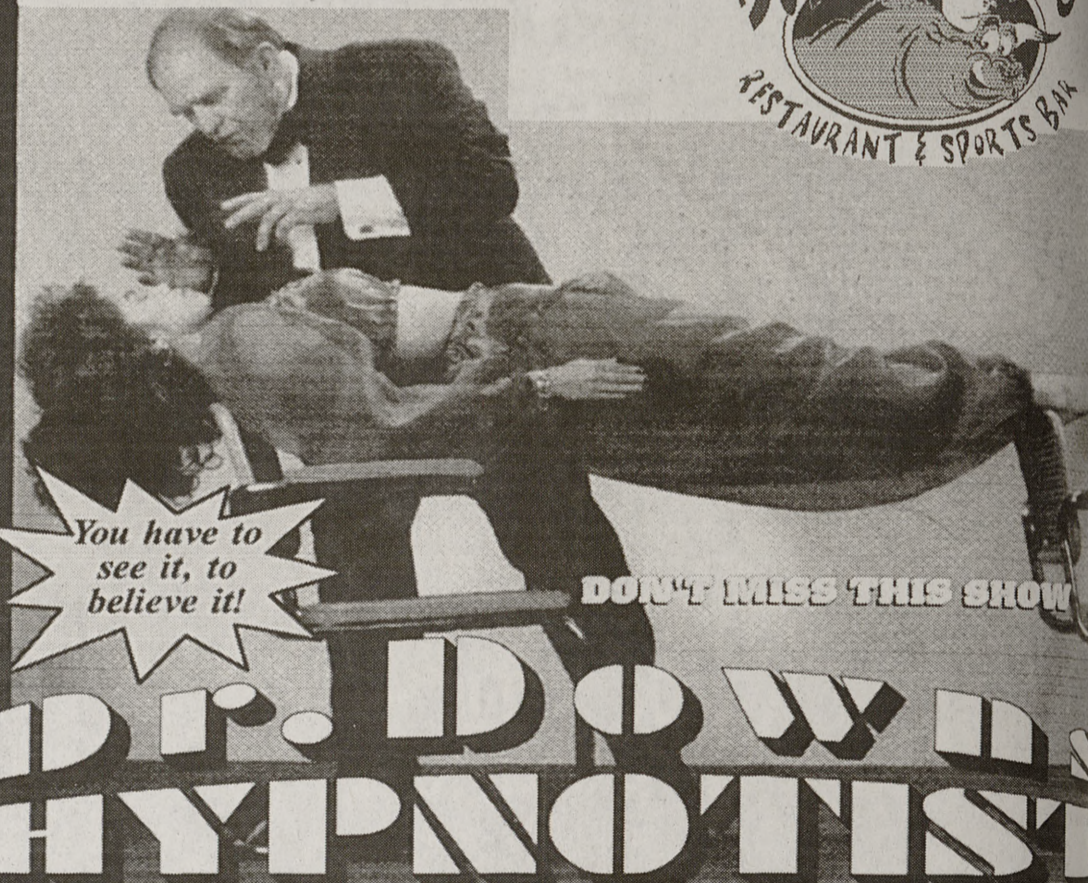
