Record crowd sees Oilers
MEMPHIS, Tenn. Michael Hayes got a bit of a surprise when he turned out to be Tennessee Oilers' home Sunday. He actually had in line to buy a ticket.
The Oilers, in Memphis two-year stay before moving to Nashville, have had empty seats for their home game on Sunday, they drew a crowd since moving to the city in July as 31,042 fans at the 62,360-seat Liberty Bowl.
It wasn't hard to find a ticket Sunday, but the Oilers' home game, the first since they moved into the first half at a new stadium.

Charles Gibbons said he was surprised by the wait. Sporting a Dallas Cowboys cap, Gibbons said he came to the game in hopes of watching the Redskins win.
"It could be good for the Cowboys," he said.
Tracy Lopez, Jim Goggin, Angela Grisby drove in Jacksonville, Ark., about 100 miles west of Memphis, in hopes of seeing the Redskins win.
They were still in line to get tickets as the first half was drawn close. They missed the Redskins touchdowns, both by the Oilers.
