



NEW YORK (AP) — An exciting Game 7 may have rescued NBC from having the lowest television rating of any World Series.

The overnight rating for Game was a 26.0 with a 39 share, the highest rating for a Series game since the 32.2 in Game 7 of the Twins-Braves in 1991, the last Series to go seven games.

The rating, however, was the lowest for a Game 7 since 1968 when the Cardinals-Tigers game got a 21.2 rating in an afternoon game.

Combined with the 16.9 overnight rating from Game 6, the 1997 Series may pull ahead of the 16.4 rating from 1989 earthquake-interrupted Series between the Oakland A's and San Francisco Giants.
