That is precisely what happened with Kansas State QB Bishop. Bishop had less than exemplary grades in high school and was recruited by A&M. Our coaches suggested he attend Blinn, get a little experience and get used to studying. His grades remained mediocre. He took a pass and didn't sign. What this demonstrates is R.C. Slocum is attempting to do a perfect football program where athletes are successful in the field, in the classroom and in general. He deserves patience while we see if he can realize his goals.

According to Sports Illustrated Director Alan Cannon, Slocum's main desire for the A&M team is to "recruit players of character."

Oh my God. Here's a football coach who says "football is the No. 1 priority—building of character, heart and integrity is the most important." Is there some sort of revolutionary something? No, he just hasn't spent the entire sum of an adult life coaching football, messing the way the game is played. People sometimes, R.C. Slocum genuinely cares about his players and the goings-on in their lives. He also cares more about his players becoming strong-minded, sensible and most of all, educated. He does about their particular accomplishments on the field.

Let's not forget we are collectively Texas A&M UNIVERSITY. This is still an institute of higher learning—not an institute of scoring. Slocum has his practice exactly where they ought to be, lately it seems as if some of us forgot what is really important.
